Keeping in view the extension of lock down due to pandemic created by Corona Virus, the function of the Court in the District Judiciary, Dhubri is to be resumed through the process of online.

It is to be mentioned worth here that e-filing of cases has yet not been materialized owing to some technical snag and also because of want of formal order to be had from the Hon'ble Gauhati Court, Guwahati, E-committee. Accordingly, it is resolved that the urgent matter particularly in bail petition which relates to liberty of a person within the meaning of law is to be file through e-mail.
