

OFFICE OF THE DISTRICT AND SESSIONS JUDGE, DHUBRI**GENERAL ORDER**No...25... Dated 16th March, 2020

Keeping in view the menace of COVID-19, the Novel Corona Virus which is recognized by the World Health Organization as pandemic nature which has flared-up almost 118 (one hundred and eighteen) countries covering more than one lakh thirty thousand (till writing this report), the Hon'ble Gauhati High Court has been pleased to issue some instructions and guidelines to the Subordinate Judiciary only with a view to combat and to prevent the virus in an epidemic stage. The District Judiciary, Dhubri in presence of senior Judicial Officers have decided to comply with the guidelines as follows:

1) The District Judiciary, Dhubri is of the view that in order to monitor for complying the guidelines of the Hon'ble Gauhati High Court and to give in such monitoring, a committee is constituted by the following Judicial Officers:

- a) Shri R.A. Tapadar, Addl. District and Sessions Judge, Dhubri as Chairman.
- b) Smti. Dimple Boro, Chief Judicial Magistrate, Dhubri as Member.
- c) Shri Rajesh Bodo, Civil Judge and Asstt. Sessions Judge, Dhubri as Member.
- d) Shri Shah Syed Ahadur Rahman, Secretary, DLSA, Dhubri as Member.

2) It is resolved that each Court of the Judicial Officers is to be restricted in entry gate by the security personnel engaged for the Court to check the entry of the persons including advocates, accused, witness in reciprocal in order to avoid the crowd and gathering within the precinct of the Court. The security personnel may call out the name of the accused or witness only to attend the Court at entry gate and after exhausting the proceeding of the Court, the next call will have to carry out by the security personnel.

3) In the stage of argument of the case, the learned advocate may give written argument instead of oral one and in selected case; they may be allowed to have adjournment.

4) The team of Court official will work round the clock (during office hours) to prevent gathering of people in and around the Court campus. The committee also resolved to urge upon the people to identify the unknown persons

(strangers) who may come to the Court precinct or bar for the first time so as to enable other to come in contact with them.

5) Regarding sanitizer of Court premises, the existing sweeper staffs are directed to make sanitization of each room, ej-lash and all the place where the avenues of person to person contact is found available. The additional sweeper staffs may be engaged in order to comply and to give effect to this order.

6) The District Legal Services Authority is to take necessary arrangement for supply sanitary mask to the needy persons as and when necessary particularly those persons who are suffering for cough, sneezing and the Secretary, DLSA team including some selected PLVs are also to the streamline in this regard.

7) In order to give effect these guidelines, the following staff members are pacifically entrusted to guide and monitor and to participate physically.


- a) All Sheristadars of the department
- b) All Head Assistants
- c) Shri Sunilam Deb Adhikary, Accountant
- d) Shri Prabir Kumar Ghosh, LDA
- e) Shri Rajesh Ch. Boro, LDA
- f) Shri Pulakesh Nath, LDA
- g) Miss Megha Bhaduri, LDA
- h) Miss Debopriya Mukharjee, Copyist
- i) Miss Jilima Ray, Office Peon

8) It is also urged upon the public to keep separate each of them at least at a distant of about six feet each other. It is felt that prevention is only the medicine of this hybrid virus which can show that India will win and the Corona virus will be defeated.

The aforesaid guidelines are to be closely monitored by the committee (team) so constituted until further order.

Let the instructions / guidelines be circulated by hanging in Notice Board and conspicuous place of the Court campus and the copy of the same be given to the President and Secretary of Dhubri, Bilasipara and Hatsingimari Bar Association with a request to follow the pursue as in the light of the aforesaid guidelines.
